To make sending overseas easier and more convenient, from 11 January 2020 we're introducing a new CN23 label printing layout on eParcel.

Label Print Layout Changes

Question	Answer
What is current state?	Previously when printing consignments containing multiple A5 (CN23) labels to single label countries (eg. US, UK and NZ), the CN23 labels are produced with one CN23 label printed per A4 page (A4-1PP).
What is the change	Now we've added a new label layout option for International eParcel customers. When generating multiple A5 CN23 shipping labels to single label lanes, consignments can be printed in the layout of two single CN23 labels per A4 page (A4-2PP) – therefore taking up the entire space of the A4 page.
